### City of Inverness Drinking Water System

#### System Flushing and Temporary Modifications of Disinfection Treatment Process

Dear City of Inverness Water Customer,

The City of Inverness works to bring the highest quality standards for clean safe drinking water to our customers. From November 1<sup>st</sup> through December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016, we will conduct system flushing and temporarily change the disinfection process from chloramines to free chlorine in the drinking water supply.

This process is regulated by State Agencies and will not cause adverse health effects. You may notice some discoloration, cloudiness or excessive air in water lines. You may not experience much of anything, but if you do, we highly recommend that you run the water until it comes clear. Some areas may experience a temporary fluctuation in water pressure or a slight increase in taste and odor of chlorine.

This is a temporary modification to the treatment process. This is a common practice for water suppliers using chloramines for disinfection and recommended by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. A small inconvenience today will help maintain excellent water tomorrow.
