



YARD WASTE GUIDELINES

We want your experience to be the best possible and are providing a friendly reminder of the limitations and procedures for yard waste collection service:

- Small yard waste materials (leaves, grass clippings, pine needles, materials with thorns, small branches) must be bagged, boxed or containerized.
- Larger yard waste materials should be neatly stacked at the curb.
- Materials cannot exceed four (4) feet in length or four (4) inches in diameter, and should not exceed two (2) cubic yards in size (about the size of a standard pickup truck bed).
- No container or bundle may exceed fifty (50) pounds.
- If the total amount of yard waste exceeds 2 cubic yards, please divide it into piles. A portion of the waste will be collected each week until it has all been removed.
- Please do not place yard waste on the street, City right of way, or on a vacant lot. Community piles are not acceptable.

We understand that you may desire to have large piles removed immediately or that you may have materials larger than the size limits of our standard collection service. In this case, we will be happy to provide you a quote for these services.
